ENHANCED ADMISSION PROCESS DURING COVID-19

During these challenging times, Edelweiss Village is committed to ensuring the safety and well-being of all as we prepare to accept new residents. Below you will find our enhanced admission process so that residents may transition when they are ready in the safest way possible.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT DURING THE TOURING AND ADMISSION PROCESS AT EDELWEISS VILLAGE.

TOURING:

A virtual tour is available via FaceTime. A slideshow with photos of our grounds and building is available on our website. On-site tours will resume pending regulatory approval.

ADMISSION AND MOVE-IN POLICIES:

- An application must be completed before a health assessment can be done. The application can be found on our website on the Admissions page or by contacting us at 857-547-2000.
- All applicants will be assessed by our nurse either virtually or in person, keeping social distancing in mind.
- All new residents must test negative for COVID-19 within 48 hours of move-in.
- Masks are required upon entering the building and must remain in place in public areas.
- Upon entering Edelweiss Village, each person will be screened for temperature and answer questions about COVID-related symptoms. If a temperature is over 100 degrees or an answer on the questionnaire shows exposure to the virus, the individual will not be able to enter the building.
- Only one family member is allowed to assist the resident with unpacking personal belongings. They must also consent to screening prior to entering the building.
- For your safety and the safety of our residents and staff, we require a 14-day quarantine in your apartment due to the potential spread of this virus (even if you have no symptoms). Once the quarantine is over, residents are allowed family visits during scheduled times. Please inquire with the concierge about the schedule.
